TO ALL THE RESTAURANT OWNERS/MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

RE: PROTOCOL FOR MANAGEMENT OF RESTAURANTS AND EATERIES DURING THE PERIOD OF COVID-19


Following the Government Directive to allow sit-ins in restaurants and eateries, you are hereby directed to collect the following documents from the public health facilities or Public health offices near you:

1. The protocol for management of restaurant and eateries.

After familiarization with the protocol which stipulates all the requirements, Restaurants and eateries that wish to start operations should:

1. Apply for a permit from the County Director Public Health using Form A attached to these protocols.
2. Their premises will then be inspected using Form B.
NB: It's also a requirement that samples for corona virus (COVID-19) testing will be taken and a fee of Kshs 1000 (one thousand) per sample will be charged.
3. Once conditions are met a permit (Form C) to operate food business during the Covid-19 pandemic will be issued.
4. If the conditions are not met, permission will not be granted to operate and the business entity will be required to work with the Public Health Officers to meet these conditions.

By today we have tested 54 people from the restaurants and eateries. The results are negative and we encourage all restaurants and eateries to follow suite in-order to reopen this integral niche of our Laikipian economy.
