THE LAIKIPIA COUNTY TRADE LICENSING BILL, 2026

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Laikipia to establish a framework and provide a mechanism for the imposition of certain charges, fees and for the grant of trade licenses for all businesses and trade within the county and for connected matters and incidental purposes

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Laikipia as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Laikipia County Trade Licensing Act, 2026 and shall come into force upon publication.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

"approved form" means a form approved by the licensing authority or form set out in the First Schedule;

"authorized officer" has the meaning assigned to it under section 6;

"business" includes a trade or occupation;

"county" means Laikipia County;

"county assembly" means Laikipia County Assembly;

"county government" means the County Government of Laikipia;

"executive committee member" means the Executive Committee Member responsible for trade in the County;

"holder" in relation to a trade license, means the person to whom the license is granted or to whom a trade license is transferred or assigned to;

"license fee" means the fee payable for the grant or renewal of a trade license as prescribed in the Second Schedule of this Act;

"licensing authority" means an officer of the county government appointed under section 4;

"premises" means any structure, whether of a permanent or temporary nature, in which trade is carried on and includes a motor vehicle if trade is carried on it;

"receiver of revenue" means the Laikipia County Revenue Agency established under section 4 of the Laikipia County Revenue Administration and Management Act

"trade license" means a license granted under this Act or any other law to conduct a business within the County and shall be in the prescribed form in the Third Schedule.

Object and Purpose

3. The object and purpose of this Act is to—

- a) Provide a framework within which the County Government may perform its functions and exercise its powers under the Constitution to license certain business activities;
- b) Establish a framework for the conduct and regulation of business in the County; and
- c) Establish a mechanism to reliably raise revenue in the County to enable the County Government to deliver services effectively.

PART II—ADMINISTRATION

Designation of the licensing authority

4. (1) The Chief Officer responsible for trade matters shall be the licensing authority for purposes of this Act.

(2) The licensing authority may designate or appoint a County Public Officer in writing as a licensing officer in every county department or as he or she may deem necessary.

Role and Functions of the licensing authority

5. (1) without prejudice to the generality of section 4, the licensing authority shall be responsible for granting trading licenses in the County and shall —

- (a) Grant and issue licenses under this Act and any other applicable law;
- (b) Be an authorized officer under this Act for the purpose of the Laikipia County Revenue Administration and Management Act; and
- (c) Perform such other functions as may be delegated by the County receiver of revenue for the purpose of the Laikipia County Revenue Administration and Management Act.

(2) The licensing authority may, whenever necessary, delegate any of his or her functions other than a function under sub section (1)(c) to any other person or institution appointed pursuant to section 6 of this Act.

Power of licensing authority to appoint authorized officers

6. (1) The Licensing authority may appoint in writing a County Public Officer to be an authorized officer for purposes of this Act.

(2) The Licensing authority shall issue county identification cards to officers appointed as authorized officers.

Identification of officers

7. All authorized officers shall at all material times in the course of their duties, put on a uniform, carry and have in their possession a proper identification badge, issued by and bearing the authority of the Board.

Powers of Authorized Officers

8. 1) An authorized officer appointed under Section 6 may —
- a) enter any premises to-
 - (i) Inspect it in relation to an application for grant or renewal of a license; or
 - (ii) Confirm whether the license holder is complying with the provisions of this Act, the Regulations and the conditions of the license.
 - b) Search the premises or any part of the premises;
 - c) Inspect or examine anything in or on the premises;
 - d) Seize anything that may afford evidence of the commission of an offence against this Act;
 - e) Take extracts from, and take copies of, any documents in or on the premises;
 - f) Take into or onto the premises such persons, equipment and materials as the authorized officer reasonably requires for the purpose of exercising any of the powers mentioned in paragraphs (a) to (e); or
 - g) Require the licensee, or any person in or on the premises, to give to the authorized officer reasonable assistance in relation to the exercise of any of the powers mentioned in paragraphs (a) to (f)
- (2) Nothing contained in sub-section (1) shall permit the licensing authority or an authorized officer to enter the premises unless it is during the normal working hours of the business.

PART III—LICENSING PROCEDURE

Types of Trade Licenses to be issued

9. (1) New Business Trade License.
(2) Continuing Business Trade License

Requirement for a Trade License

10. (1) Save and except as may be provided in any other written law, any person intending to carry on or conduct any business or trade in the County shall first apply to the authority and obtain a license as provided in this Act or other written law of the County.
- (2.) Every person carrying on or conducting a business or trade in the County shall take out a trade license in respect thereof which shall expire on 31st December on the year of issue on such terms and conditions as may be prescribed.
- (3.) No person shall conduct a business or carry on a business or trade within the County, unless the person is the holder of a valid trade license in accordance with this Act or other County law.

- (4.) Any person carrying on business within the jurisdiction of the County who fails to renew a trade license by 31st March of the current trading year or any past years shall be guilty of an offence.
- (5.) A person who contravenes subsection (2) and (3) commits an offence, and shall upon conviction be liable to pay the license fees owed to the county together with a fine not exceeding twenty thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both.
- (6.) A distributor who is delivering goods to retailers within the county shall not be required to hold a trade license unless the distributor's premises is within the county or directly sells goods to consumers within the county but shall hold other applicable licenses.

Application for Trade Licence

11. (1) An application under section 9 for a grant of a trade license shall—

- a) be in the approved form set out in the First Schedule of this Act;
 - b) contain such information and accompanied by such documents as may be required by the approved form;
 - c) be signed in a manner specified in approved form;
 - d) be lodged with the licensing authority; and
 - e) be accompanied by the prescribed application fee which shall be non-refundable
- (2) It shall be lawful for an application to be made in an electronic format approved by the licensing authority.
- (3) The Application fee once paid is not refundable and non-transferable.

Differential referencing to issuance of license for new business

12. (1) The Licensing Authority shall ensure that a new trader has been issued with a special business permit depending on what time they take out a trade License as in Subsection 2 of this Section.

(2) A new business will be issued with a trade license in the following manner-

- a) For a new business realized in the beginning of the Calendar year full Single Business Permit fee shall be paid as under Section 10 (a). For a new business realized in the third quarter of the calendar year a 50% waiver of the Single Business Permit fee described in Section 10 above shall apply
- b) For a new business realized in the last quarter of the calendar year a full waiver for the fee obtaining the trade license for the current calendar year shall apply and issuance of a trade license for the following year shall be made.
- c) This waiver will only apply to the Single Business Permit Fee and not applicable to fees charged together with Single Business Permit License Fee.

Approval and grant of license

13. (1). On consideration of the application, the licensing authority may approve and grant the license applied for if satisfied that —

- (a) The applicant has complied with all the requirements for a grant of the license, including any requirements as to health, hygiene and safety applicable to the trade license applied for; and
- (b) The intended business is a legal business under the laws of Kenya.
- (c) Inspection has been done and an invoice issued
- (b) The license fee has been paid to the receiver of revenue.
- (2) A trade license granted under this section shall be in the form approved by the licensing authority and shall be granted subject to such conditions as may be specified therein.
- (3) A trade license shall itemize the nature and kind of business or businesses which the holder is allowed to undertake, premises and location where the business is located.
- (4) A trade license may be granted for each of related businesses being undertaken within the same space provided that they are owned by the same proprietor and provided the owner has met all the conditions required for the conduct of the businesses under the relevant laws.

Renewal of licenses

14. (1) A holder of a trade license who wishes to continue to carry on, conduct the same business or trade in the County shall, before the expiry of his or her trade license, apply in the prescribed form for the renewal of the license.

(2) Upon consideration of the application under subsection (1), the licensing authority may grant the application for the renewal if —

- (a) the applicant has complied with all laws relating to health, hygiene and safety applicable to the trade license;
- (b) the applicant has not been in breach of the conditions or any of the conditions in the expiring license;
- (c) the renewal fees has been paid to the receiver of revenue; and
- (d) the license fees payable for the renewal of the trade license has been paid to the receiver of revenue.

Business Categories

15. For purposes of this Act, the categories, classification, description and applicable charges relating to businesses and trades shall be as prescribed under the Laikipia County Finance Act, as amended or replaced from time to time.

Identification of officers

16. All authorized officers shall at all material times in the course of their duties, put on a uniform, carry and have in their possession a proper identification badge, issued by and bearing the authority of the Authorizing Authority.

Cancellation of a license

17. (1). The licensing authority may cancel or suspend a business or trade license granted under this Act if satisfied that —

- a. The conduct of the business is endangering the health or safety of persons who live or work in the neighborhood of the premises from which the business is conducted; or
- b. The holder of the trade license has breached a condition of the license.

Provided that the licensing authority shall give the holder of a trade license notice not exceeding fourteen days of its intended cancellation or suspension within which the holder of the license may make representation to the licensing authority.

- (2.) If a trade license is cancelled or suspended, the holder of the license shall immediately cease to conduct the business.
- (3.) A person who contravenes subsection (3) commits an offence, and shall upon conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty thousand shillings or imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or both.
- (4.) Where the authority cancels or suspends a license, the licensing authority shall give the holder of the license a written notice of the cancellation, suspension or revocation, together with a statement of the reasons for the decision.
- (5.) On the suspension, cancellation or revocation of a trade license holder of the license shall be at liberty to resume the business in respect thereof upon compliance with the requirements of issuing the license.

Surrender of license

18. A holder of a trade license may, after giving a written notice to the licensing authority surrender the license by returning it to the licensing authority, provided that the surrender shall not entitle the holder to a refund of any fees or part fees paid in respect thereof.

Register of licenses

19. (1). The licensing authority shall, in consultation with the county receiver of revenue, establish and maintain a register of trade licenses or a separate register in respect of each type of trade license issued in the County containing information as may be prescribed.

- (1) The register must contain such information as is prescribed and which is not confidential
- (2) Every trade license granted in the County shall be entered in the register or the separate register in respect of the trade and which shall, at a reasonable fee, be available for public inspection during usual government office hours.

Appeal against Cancellation of a license

- 20.** (1) A person aggrieved by a decision of the licensing authority may appeal to the Executive Member against the decision.
- (2) Executive Member may confirm, reverse or modify the decision appealed against, and give such directions to the licensing authority as may be necessary to give effect to the member's decision.
- (3) The Licensing authority shall comply with any direction given under subsection (2).
- (4) Nothing in this section shall be construed to bar any aggrieved person from seeking any other legal redress.

PART IV—OFFENCES

Penalty for offence under part III

- 21.** (1) Any person who gives any statement in relation to a trade license or other matter under this Act, which the person knows to be false or misleading to the licensing authority or authorized officer commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both.
- (2) A public officer who aids or abets the commission of an offence under this Act commits an offence and is liable, upon conviction, to the same fine or term of imprisonment as the principal offender.

General Offences

- 22.** Where a person contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of this Act and a penalty thereof is not expressly provided by this Act, that person shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding Kenya Shillings twenty thousand or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or both.

PART V—MISCELLANEOUS

Savings

- 23.** (1) License or permit in force before the commencement of this Act, shall be deemed to have continued in force, subject to subsection (2), on and after that date as if it were a license or permit granted under this Act, and any fees or charges payable to any local authority in respect of that permit shall be payable to the county government.
- (2) The license or permit referred to in subsection (1) shall continue to be in force-
- (3) Until the expiry of the term of such license of permit; or

- (4) Where the holder of the license or permit has applied for a trade license under this Act within that period, until the license is granted or refused, or the application is withdrawn, whichever occurs first.

Regulations

24. The Executive Committee Member may make regulations generally for the better carrying out of the provisions and purposes of this Act.
