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I. KEY ENTITY INFORMATION AND MANAGEMENT

(a) Background information

The County is constituted as per The Constitution of Kenya 2010 and operates as guided by the County Government Act 2012. The county is headed by the County Governor, who is responsible for the general policy and strategic direction of the County.

The county has three sub-counties: Laikipia North, Laikipia East and Laikipia West. It is divided into three constituencies and 15 wards. Laikipia County borders 7 counties namely Samburu to the North, Isiolo to the North East, Meru to the East, Nyeri to the South East, Nyandarua and Nakuru to the South West and Baringo to the West. Laikipia County covers an area of 9,462 KM² (2,338,111 acres).

Laikipia's economy is fairly diversified with the lead sectors being: agriculture, wholesale and retail trade, financial and insurance services, public administration and defence, transport and storage, and construction.

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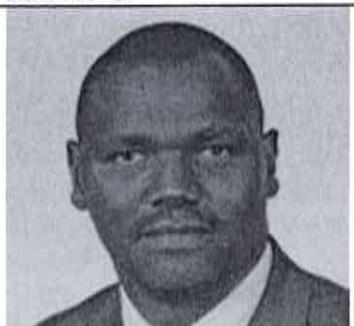

She is a member of Institute of Human Resource Management and has published a journal, "Training of Employees in County Governments"



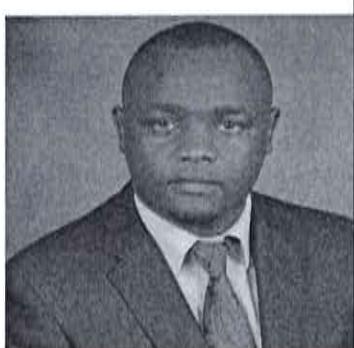
Biwott Tirop - CECM Trade, Tourism, Co-operatives and Industrialization

A doctor of Medicine and Surgery, Public health and International Health Systems Manager.

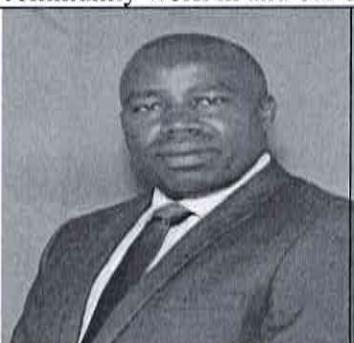

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II. FORWARD BY THE CECM FINANCE ECONOMIC PLANNING AND COUNTY DEVELOPMENT

It is my pleasure to present the Laikipia County Government's Quarterly Financial Reports for the 2nd Quarter ended 31st December 2019. The County Government of Laikipia Financial Statements for the second quarter have been prepared in line with The PFM Act 2012 and are in line with the format prescribed by The Public Sector Accounting Standards Board. The PFM Act 2012 Section 166 (4) requires that these statements be submitted to The County Assembly and copies be submitted to The National Treasury, The Office of the Controller of Budget and The Commission of Revenue Allocation within one month after end of each quarter.

The link between policy, planning, budgeting and reporting continues being critical as provided for in the Constitution and County Government Act. The financial statements play a critical role in the decision making, management and accountability of public resources. To strengthen the public finance management, the County government will continue to embrace timely financial reporting and deepen public financial reforms e.g. use of the Laikipia County Statistical abstract which is prepared annually as part of budget preparation, project management and strengthening of the financial reporting unit to increase efficiency and effectiveness in service delivery.

The County is committed in ensuring transparency by relaying performance indicators to the public. This will be realized through publishing and publicising financial and non-financial reports as required by the Constitution and the PFM Act 2012.

Pursuant to the PFM Act 2012 Section 149 I confirm that there was accountability to the county assembly in ensuring that the resources of the county government were authorised and lawfully utilised in an effective, efficient, economical and transparent manner.

FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE

1. REVENUE

In Quarter 2, the County budgeted for Kshs. 1,630,727,105 of which Kshs. 830,488,503 was realized which represents a 50.93% budget realization. The county realized 64.87% of its equitable share, 74.47% of its own generated receipts, 15.96 % of foreign grants and 33.22% fuel levy.

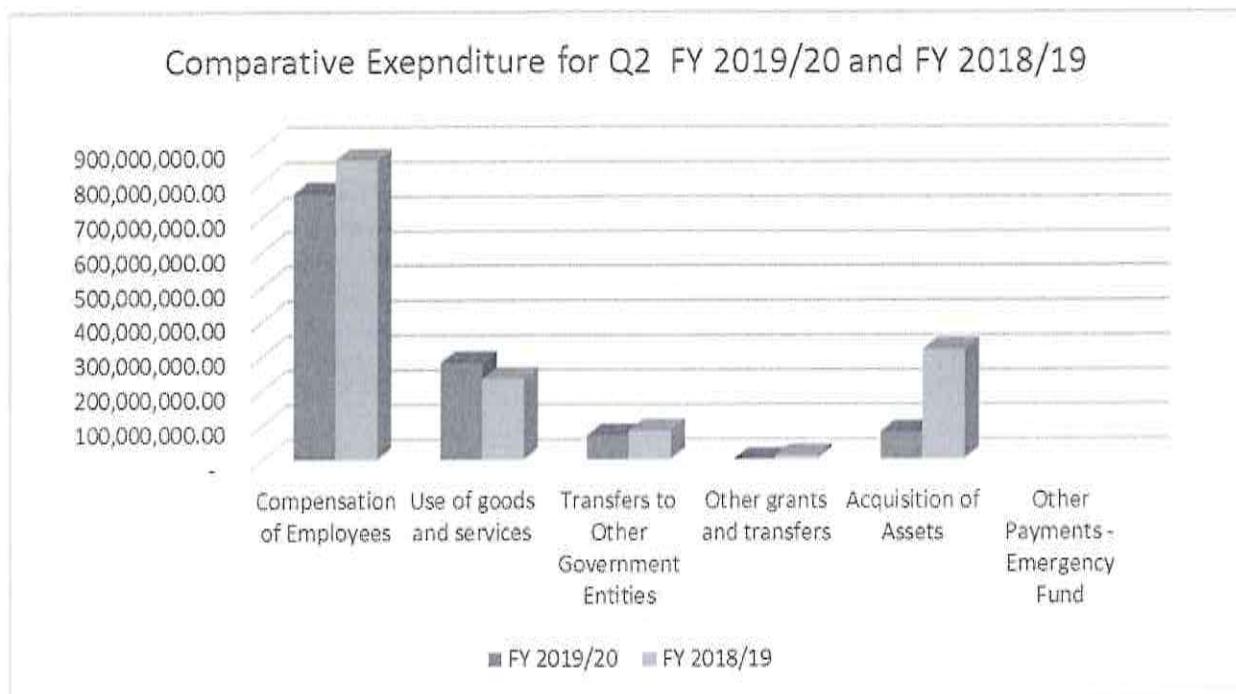

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2. PAYMENTS

In Quarter 2, the expenditure figures for recurrent stood at Ksh. 1,195,222,309 against budget estimate of Ksh. 1,980,592,617 for the county government executive which represents 60.35% budget utilisation in the quarter and an overall utilisation of 62.52% for the half year of 2019/20 financial year. Recurrent Expenditure amounted to Kshs. 1,047,848,759 while Development Expenditure amounted to Kshs. 147,373,550.

The total expenditure for quarter 2 in FY 2019/20 was Kshs. 1,195,222,309 as compared to Kshs. 1,510,384,861 in FY 2018/19 as illustrated in the bar chart below;



OPERATIONAL PERFORMANCE

The county's operations are structured in terms of departments which are headed by County Executive Committee Members who are appointed by the Governor with approval by the County Assembly.

The county government is focused on improving service delivery to the public through the ongoing public sector performance review and tracking, increasing productivity in agriculture, manufacturing and innovation, as well as increase universal health care and coverage to reduce the medical cost burden and to continue being the lead county in life expectancy.

LAIKIPIA COUNTY AUDIT COMMITTEE

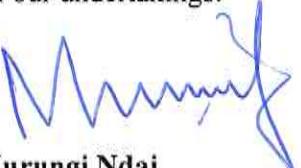
CONCLUSION

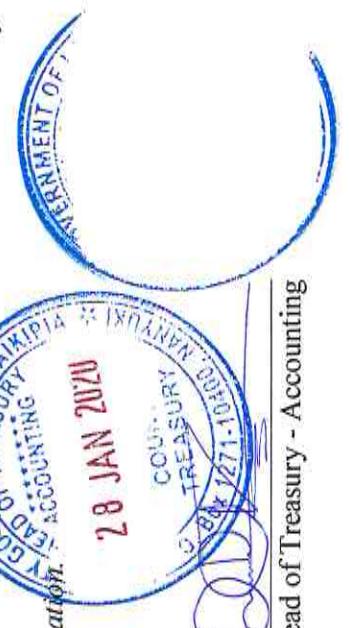

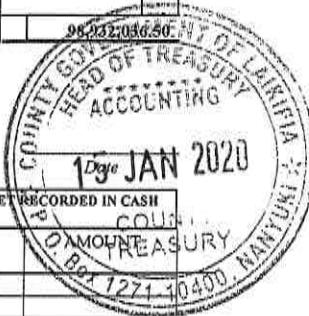

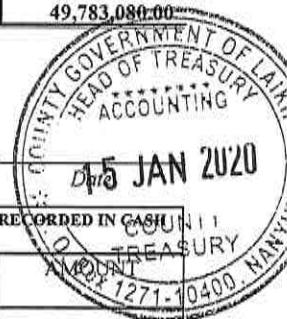
