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THE LAIKIPIA COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2023

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Laikipia to provide for the imposition or variation and collection of various permit fees, cess, licenses, fees or charges and for connected purposes.

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Laikipia, as follows—

PART 1—PRELIMINARIES

1. This Act may be cited as the Laikipia County Finance Act, 2023 and shall come into operation on the date of publication in the *Gazette* as an Act of the County Assembly.

Short title and
commencement

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires-

Interpretation

“Agricultural produce” means any agricultural crop or animal produce;

“Campsite” – means a collection of tents, huts, or other temporary structures used for travelers to sleep in, outdoors. A tent is a portable shelter made of fabric and supported by a frame or poles. Could also be an open space with manicured lawns where the tents could be set up temporarily.

“Chief Executive Officer” means the officer designated as such under section 9 of the Laikipia County Revenue Board act.

“Cottage/Holiday home” - means a small vacation house, typically in a rural area.

“County Revenue Board” means a body responsible for collection of all revenues of the County Government of Laikipia as established under the Laikipia Revenue Board Act 2014.

“Eco-lodges” – means environmentally friendly accommodation aiming to promote sustainable tourism and green living through the use of renewable energy sources, recycled materials, and organic locally-sourced produce. Their philosophy is to minimize the impact on the environment.

“Four-star hotels” – (first class hotels) - They maintain a high quality of furnishings, decorations and equipment.

Bedrooms are spacious (single 16 m2, double 22 m2) and well designed, with en-suite bathrooms with a bath and shower. There is enough staff to provide all necessary service; there is a 24-hour room service, laundry; a lobby, an a la carte restaurant and a bar. All rooms are equipped with mini-bars and access to internet.

“Guest house” - means a private house offering accommodation to paying guests to include AirBnB, Serviced Apartments and Furnished Apartments.

“Home stay” – it is a type of guesthouse, where in addition to lodging and breakfast, guests are also offered lunch and dinner. Home stays are usually family-run and cost less than other accommodation options.

“Large enterprise” means a firm, trade, service, industry or a business activity-

- (a) whose annual turnover is above one hundred million
- (b) which employs above one hundred employees
- (c) whose capital investment is above fifty million

“Locality” means neighborhood of the slaughterhouse (the Town within which the Slaughterhouse is located).

“Medium enterprise” means a firm, trade, service, industry or a business activity

- (a) whose annual turnover ranges between fifty million and one hundred million
- (b) which employs between fifty and one hundred employees
- (c) Whose capital investment ranges between twenty million and fifty million

“Medium urban zones” means an urban zone classified under the Twelfth Schedule;

“Micro enterprise" means a firm, trade, service, industry or a business activity-

- (a) whose annual turnover does not exceed five hundred thousand shillings;
- (b) which employs less than ten people; and
- (c) whose total assets and financial investment shall

be as determined from time to time, and includes;

- (i) the manufacturing sector, where the investment in plant and machinery or the registered capital of the enterprise does not exceed ten million shillings;
- (ii) the service sector and farming enterprises where the investment in equipment or registered capital of the enterprise does not exceed five million shilling

“Mobile hawker” means a person who attends a particular market with their goods, in the hope that they may be allocated a trading position for that day only, from the vacant positions in the market;

“One star hotel” – (tourist hotels - low budget/economy hotels) - Hotels are mostly small and privately owned services may be provided by the owner and the family. Meals may be fairly simple. Rooms are small (single 8m², double 12 m²). All rooms have a shower and a toilet in the room (Standard). / Some rooms may not have en suite bathrooms. All rooms have a hand-basin with hot and cold running water. Telephone is available. Breakfast is available. Drinks are offered. Guests can enter or leave any time of the day or night.

“Single Business Permit”, in relation to a business, means a license granted under this Act to conduct the business;

“Small enterprise” means a firm, trade, service, industry or a business activity-

- (a) whose annual turnover ranges between five hundred and five million shillings; and
- (b) which employs between ten and fifty people; and
- (c) whose total assets and financial investment shall be as determined by the from time to time and includes;
- (i) the manufacturing sector, where the investment in plant and machinery as well as the registered capital of the enterprise is between ten million and fifty million shillings; and
- (ii) service and farming enterprises, where the

equipment investment as well as registered capital of the enterprise is between five million and twenty million shillings

“Small urban zone” means an urban zone classified under twelve Schedule;

“Tented camps” - means a permanent campsite of large accommodation units, usually with canvas walls, solid high-quality furnishings, en-suite bathroom facilities, and private decks for observing wildlife. Situated throughout Africa, they range from comfortable to ultra-luxury and offer a wide range of safari-based activities.

“Three-star hotels” – (middle class hotels – comfort hotels) - Usually hotels of a size to support higher staffing levels (single rooms 14 m² and double 18 m²). They have spacious reception with seats and other public rooms. All rooms have en suite bath and shower rooms with toiletries and good equipment, such as a TV set, a hair dryer, and direct dial telephone. They usually offer room service and some business services. Access to the net is available. Credit cards are accepted.

“Towns” means a town as defined by the Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011 and as classified under the twelve schedule.

“Two-star hotels” – (standard hotels - budget hotels) - Hotels are small to medium sized (single rooms 12 m², double 16 m²). They are well equipped, offering comfortable accommodation with en-suite bath/shower rooms. Reception staff is professional, food and drinks are offered. Cashless payment is possible.

“Villa/Private house” - means a luxurious country residence.

PART XII B

1. A person operating a plot, house, shop or a stall leased or rented out by the county government shall be charged an annual or monthly rent at the rate specified in the Eighth Schedule.
2. The rent chargeable under Part XII A shall be:
 - (a) in the case of a plot be paid in advance by 31st March of every year.
 - (b) in the case of a house/stall be paid in advance by the 5th of every rent accruing month.
3. Monthly rent of a house, shop or a stall that remains outstanding after 5th day of each month shall be charged a penalty of 10% of the monthly rent
4. Penalty shall not apply to houses, shops, stalls rented to County Government of Laikipia staff whose rent is paid through check-off system

Eviction and Repossession

1. A person who fails to pay the rent payable under Part XII A of Schedule 8 for three consecutive months shall be issued with one month eviction notice to vacate from the house, shop or stall and the measures taken to recover outstanding debts shall apply.
2. The County Government shall repossess the stall or house upon eviction of the tenant and may rent it to other tenants.
